MESSAGE

Greetings in the name of Jesus Christ!

Last Sunday we celebrated the *Commemoration of Sts. Peter and Paul.* These saints were two of the most substantial contributors to the Christian faith in the decades following the resurrection of Jesus. Most of the letters in the New Testament were written by Peter or Paul. Peter anchored the early Christian movement in Jerusalem while Paul spread the good news to the provinces of Asia Minor. As we talked about *sainthood* and *martyrdom* we described both of these works of God as **already**, **not yet** realities in our world.

We live in an era when God's work in the world is *already* fully present in you and I, but *not yet* perfected for what it will be. Saints like Peter and Paul live in the full reality of God's presence in the world while they were alive on earth. They lived so fully in the *already* aspect of God's presence and activity in the world that the *not yet* very nearly ceased to exist. They are able to participate in that reality through the eyes of faith.

I pray we all continue to develop our eyes of faith and increasingly see where God is moving in us and in our world so that we may join God there.

June was a month where God was observably moving in our congregation.

- The Pentecost services on June 7th and 8th celebrated five baptisms down in Duck Creek (what fun!) and three new members! Welcome to all of you!!!
- The week of June 23-27 almost 20 of our young children participated with Grace Lutheran (Davenport) and Trinity Lutheran (Pleasant Val ley) for a week-long Lutheran Summer Day Camp! We had fun riding the bus together and learning from counselors sent from EWALU Camp (ELCA). It was a blast!

As God is faithful to us, I pray that we are enlivened in our faith to continue the good work that God has started in us. As the Apostle Paul tells us in his 2nd letter to the Corinthians, *God set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.*

May God bless you as we head into the summer months and celebrate the movement of God's Spirit in us and in our world!

All women of St. James are welcome to attend Sarah Circle!




